## How does it work?

Purchase Scrip cards with cash or check at face value after Mass on the weekends or in the parish office. You may also turn in Scrip order forms to the school office (your order will be filled that week). CRC purchases the Scrip cards at 1-30% less than face value (varies by retailer). CRC then earns the 1-30% difference. Think about it: you are going to spend the money anyway, so why not spend it using Scrip cards to support our parish and school at the same time?

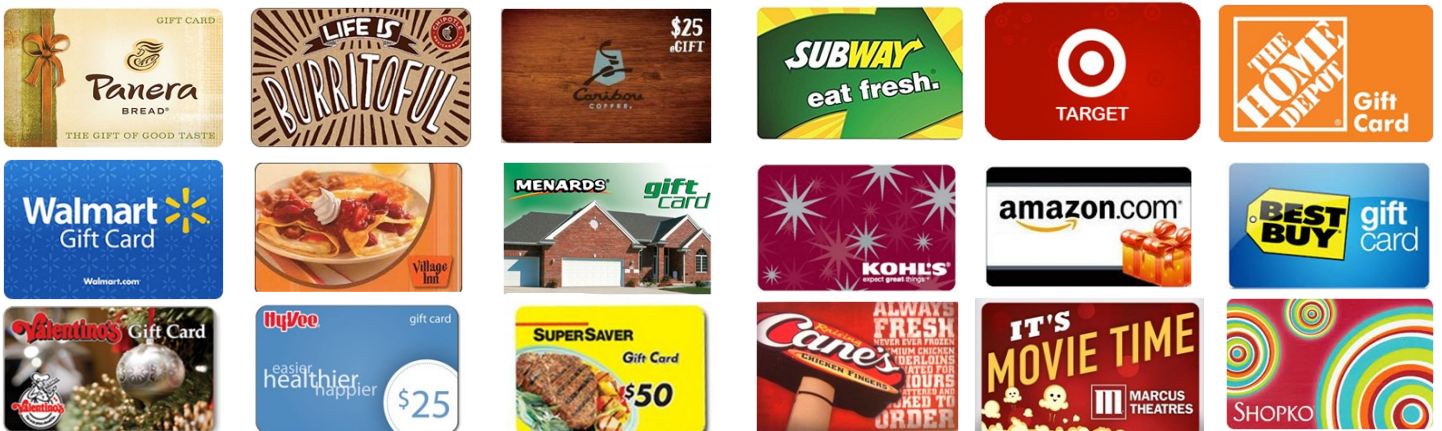

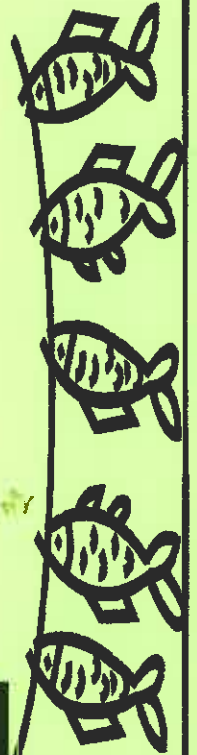
