SHOP WITH SCRIP Gift Cards and help raise money for Cathedral parish and school!



SCRIP is just another way to pay for everyday purchases using gift cards in place of cash, checks, and credit cards.

HOW IT WORKS: When the parish office orders scrip, a discount is automatically applied. For example, Raising Cane's gives us a 30% discount. If we buy \$1,000 in scrip from them, we only pay \$700. We then sell that scrip in the parish office or after Mass on the weekends for the full price of the card. With each card sold, we earn \$3. If all cards are sold, that's a total of \$300 earned! Just imagine how much that would earn for the parish and school if every family purchased scrip on a regular basis!

HOW TO ORDER: Place your completed order form with a check or cash in the parish or school offices and you'll receive your completed order the next day. Special orders (cards not in stock) must be received in the parish office by 10am on Tuesdays and can be picked up on Fridays. Order forms can be found in the parish and school offices, on the parish website: www.cathedraloftherisenchrist.org, or with the scrip sellers after weekend Masses.

CRC Scrip offers several local retailers and over 290 of the biggest brands, including grocery, department stores, gas stations, restaurants, hotels, home improvement and more. Just by using scrip to pay for your normal weekly purchases, you can easily raise hundreds of dollars per year. It's time to put your shopping dollars to work while earning money for our parish and school!
